### **Curriculum update**

**Class 1 St John's** – This week we have read the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. We have ordered pictures and written out parts of the story independently. In maths we have been estimating the total and continuing to practice our number recognition and formation up to 20. At Forest Schools we toasted marshmallows on the fire and we have all enjoyed our first school swimming lesson.

**Class 1 Pott Shrigley** – Class 1 have been working on their Quest Stories this week in literacy. They have been able to share and discuss ideas, write a fantastic plot and create an exciting adventure. In maths, we have been working on fractions and time. Swimming started for the children this week and have all really enjoyed their introductory lesson.

**Class 2 St John's** – This week in literacy we have been reading Roald Dahl's The Twits'. The children have really enjoyed the story and produced some beautiful writing. In maths we have been focusing on measuring objects using centimetres. In IPC we have been learning all about the bones in our skeleton and we have made a model of our hands and added the bones using art straws.

**Class 2 Pott Shrigley** — Class 2 have been looking at persuasive writing and debating the pros and cons of 200s. We have looked at key figures in the world and made a video as if we were William Wilberforce arguing for the end of slavery. In maths, we have explored decimals and measures.

**Class 3 St John's** – This week we have been finishing writing the final drafts of short stories- we have had some very impressive results! In maths, we have explored algebra and fractions, decimals and percentages in year 6, and the year 5s have been looking at short and long multiplication. In IPC, we have researched a country in our Holiday Show topic and have produced an information text.

**Class 3 Pott Shrigley** – This week in literacy, we have continued to draft our short fantasy stories. We are now writing them up in neat. In maths, we have been looking at short and long multiplication. In topic, we have planned a holiday for a family and written a report for them.

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
