Curriculum update

Class 1 St John's - This week the children chose to focus on pirates. In our challenge time, the children have made hats, eye patches and treasure maps. We role played being deserted on an island and then we wrote letters in bottles asking to be rescued. We have completed our learning on block graphs and tally charts.

Class 1 Pott Shrigley - This week in Class 1, we have been learning about the features of a postcard and the importance of writing an address correctly. We have carried the theme of holidays through to our maths and completed word problems about items we might take with us in our suitcase, looking specifically at addition and subtraction.

Class 2 St John's - In literacy this week we have written the opening to our dragon stories. In maths this week we have been solving word problems to do with mass. Next week we are doing an exciting project in which we will be teaching each other! We have been put into small groups and have each chosen a topic which we would love to teach the rest of the class about. We are doing Power Point presentations, making our own lesson resources and employing Mrs. Stout as our teaching assistant.

Class 2 Pott Shrigley - Class 2 have completed a descriptive piece of writing base on the experiences of the 'Lost Boys' of the Sudan. They evaluated their work using success criteria. In maths we have been revising problem solving and maths in real life contexts.

Class 3 St John's - This week, in Class 3, we have been looking at Graphic Novels in English, and we are writing our own. In Maths, we have been looking at mental calculation strategies. We have been creating artwork inspired by our 'Fairgrounds' IPC topic which is going to make a great display in the school hall. Rehearsals for the Leavers' Assembly are coming along very nicely. The Year 6s have been spending some time in their new High Schools this week.

Class 3 Pott Shrigley - In maths this week, we have been revising fractions, decimals and percentages. We have been converting between all three. In literacy, we have continued our work on Philip Pullman. We performed our play 'Jane and the Giant Peach' and had lots of fun doing this and sharing it with the parents
