Curriculum update

Class 1 St John's – This week we have focused on the non-fiction text 'Children like us: homes around the World'. We have learnt about children living in different houses and we have recreated some of the houses in our role-play. We have also looked at the differences between fiction and non-fiction texts. In maths we have used Numicon to support our number recognition skills

Class 1 Pott Shrigley – In literacy, Class 1 have written a description of a setting using adjectives, similes and adverbs. In numeracy, we have looked at finding lines of symmetry and different measures.

Class 2 St John's – This week in literacy we have read the story of Beegu. We have retold the story and sequenced it. We are also exploring story settings ready for next week. In maths we have been adding up three amounts of money using our number facts to ten. In IPC we have evaluated our sandwiches and discussed how we could have improved them.

Class 2 Pott Shrigley – This week we have started looking at some advertisements for our new literacy topic. We have also begun to look at measurement for maths. We have been measuring time, distance and capacity. In IPC, we have created our own classification keys for desert animals.

Class 3 St John's – In maths, we have been doubling and halving up to 3 digit numbers. In literacy, we have been reading and writing our own Indian folk tales and in IPC we have been learning about magnets and investigating magnetic materials.

Class 4 St John's – This week, Class 4 have been performing Lewis Carroll's 'The Walrus and the Carpenter', focusing on performance skills and memorising lines. In maths, we have been focusing on subtraction methods and finding common multiples and factors. In IPC, we have been exploring different lifecycles and creating wonderful books to present our information.

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
