Curriculum update

Class 1 St John's – This week we have focussed on the story of 'Oliver's Vegetables'. We matched the vegetables that Oliver found to the days of the week and we discussed what we could make with some of the vegetables in the story. We wrote out a shopping list for all the things we needed to make an apple crumble then on Friday, we made a delicious crumble.

On Thursday we all enjoyed a wonderful trip to The Random Apple Company where we washed, pressed and squeezed the apples from our orchard until we had lots of fresh juice to bring back to school.

Class 1 Pott Shrigley – Class 1 have been reading 'Owl Babies' and writing questions and researching owls, after our lovely trip to The Chestnut Centre. In maths, we have looked at doubling and halving.

Class 2 St John's – This week in literacy we have created story maps. In maths we have been learning how to read analogue and digital time. In IPC we have been thinking about how exercise keeps our bodies healthy and we have had a wonderful dance session based on the very hungry caterpillar.

Class 2 Pott Shrigley – This week in Class 2 we have been creating a leaflet to persuade people to visit either the Arctic or Antarctic. We have included rhetorical questions and emotive language to entice our readers. We have been learning about food chains and food webs in Science.

Class 3 St John's – In IPC, we have been exploring the equipment needed for climbing mountains. In literacy, we have been doing instructions and explanations and in maths, the children have done a maths assessment and we have spent the rest of the week addressing misconceptions.

Class 4 St John's – In maths, Class 4 have been looking at multiples, factors, prime numbers, and equivalence in fractions. In English, we have been writing cautionary tale poems. The year 5s have enjoyed two great days: one at Chester and one technology transition day. During this time, the year 6s have been writing some fantastic short stories.
