#### Curriculum update

**Class 1 St John's** – This week we have focussed on the Hindu festival of Diwali. We have learnt about the story of Rama and Sita, we've made Rangoli patterns and Diva lamps. We also joined Class Two to learn an Indian dance – please visit the website to see how we got on. In maths, we have been shape detectives – investigating the features of 2D shapes and searching for them in the environment.

**Class 1 Pott Shrigley** – Class 1 have been using the colder weather to write descriptions about a snowy scene. They have been including adjectives, adverbs and using their senses. In numeracy, we have looked at doubling and halving.

**Class 2 St John's** – In English this week we have been working on a Global learning project for which we have produced a piece of descriptive writing. We have looked at the geographical features of a setting and tried to open our sentences with prepositions to make them more interesting. In maths we have been counting in threes and looking for number patterns. In IPC we have started our new topic "What is it made from" we have been designing our own rockets and thinking about all of the different materials we would need to make them in preparation for building them in our exciting science week next week.

**Class 2 Pott Shrigley** – We began our week with looking at doubling and halving in maths and then moved on to fractions. In literacy, we have thoroughly enjoyed learning about Uganda and have started to write our recount. It has been wonderful to share our Mars Rover projects with the rest of the class.

**Class 3 St John's** – In literacy, we have been writing a recount in the role of a teddy bear. The children have also been writing about Uganda. In maths, the children have been consolidating their understanding of place value and solving place value challenges. In the afternoons, we have been doing some e-safety learning and the children have enjoyed doing a music session on rhythm.

**Class 4 St John's** – This week, Class 4 have been working on reasoning and problem solving using our knowledge of place value, rounding and negative numbers. We have also been practising a formal multiplication method. In English, we have been writing a recount in role as a teddy bear, describing what he sees when he arrives in Uganda- this has been part of a family of schools project. In IPC, we have now completed our Extreme Survivors topic, and we are excited to get going with Mission to Mars next week during the STEM buzz week.

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
