Curriculum update

Class 1 St John's – This week we have based our learning around the story of The Very Hungry Caterpillar. In maths we have ordered the days of the week and sequenced a set of events. In literacy we have been writing in speech bubbles. We have talked a lot about what makes a good friend as part of anti-bullying week, the children have all designed a mini poster showing what they think a good friend is.

Class 1 Pott Shrigley – Class 1 have been basing their literacy work around 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. We have written descriptive writing and story sequencing. In numeracy we have explored measures including capacity and length.

Class 2 St John's – This week in literacy we have been writing our own non-fiction leaflets about different sea creatures. The children have looked at the features of the non-fiction genre. In maths we have been looking at column addition and number stories. In IPC we have been continuing our work on different materials and thinking about which material would be most suitable to make a pair of curtains for the three bears. In dance we have been looking at CATS the musical and been deigning our own sequences based on the movements of a cat.

Class 2 Pott Shrigley – This week in maths, we have been converting decimals to fractions, as well as working with mixed-numbers, improper fractions and ordering fractions. We have begun to look at biographies in preparation for our new literacy topic and we have read some astronaut's biographies. We have even had a sneak preview of our school Christmas play script.

Class 3 St John's – On Monday we had an anti-bullying afternoon where the children discussed the effects of bullying. In English, we continued our poetry, such as limericks, rap and performing Benjamin Zephaniah poems. In maths the Nemo and Minions pupils have done subtraction by counting up whilst the Jessie and Sulley pupils have been learning how to do expanded subtraction. This week we also started our 'Material World' IPC topic by testing a range of materials to see if they are waterproof.

Class 4 St John's – This week, Class 4 have been working on compact division in maths. In English, we have been writing recounts in role as an alien landing on Earth. We have also started rehearsals for the Christmas Play, and we had a special visitor in to class to talk about the Great War.

Class 1 are preparing prayers for the Family Service at St Christopher's at 10.45am on Sunday morning. We hope you can join us.

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
