Curriculum update:

Class 1 – This week we have been continuing our learning around hibernation. We have looked at information books and discussed the differences between these and story books. We have written our own fact book about hedgehogs and finished making our own hedgehog models out of clay. In maths we have started learning about money; we have focussed on identifying coins and adding up 1p coins. Thank you to Class 4 for a super day on Monday, we really enjoyed being taught by you.

Class 2 – In literacy this week we have been researching how to write a diary in preparation for writing our own diary entries next week. In maths we have been counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and revising our number bonds. We have also been very busy preparing for our upcoming Nativity and Christingle service.

Class 3 – This week, in maths, we have looked at bar graphs. In our topic of 'Chocolate' we have created a timeline for the Aztec civilisation. In literacy, we have written a letter to the publishers of Charlie and the Chocolate factory asking them not to change the story.

Class 4 – This week started with 'Take Over Day'. After writing their letters of application and being interviewed for their roles, the pupils carried out their duties wonderfully, and we all had a great day. I am very proud of them all. In English, we have been writing our short stories, focusing on creating atmosphere and showing a change in character over the course of the story. In maths, we have been looking at measures, including converting from km to m, ml to l and kg to grams and visa versa. In IPC, we have been creating art work inspired by our feeling towards a special place.

Sports news – Class 1 and 2 have taken part in some fitness sessions using music and movements. Class 3 did some basketball with the new PE staff on Monday (well done to Kaiden, Jacob and Andrew). Class 4 worked on general fitness with Boxfit and fencing.

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
