In school next week:

Monday – Mrs Walker on Emotionally Healthy Schools conference. Thursday – Reception and KS1 Nativity at 2pm and 6pm in school. Saturday – PTA Christmas Fayre at school from 1 - 4pm.

Curriculum update:

Class 1 – This week in Reception we have finished our learning on hibernation. We carried out a scientific experiment after we learnt that bears hibernate in caves to keep warm. We checked that this was correct by warming up our bears (rice bags) and insulating one with fur and leaves and then placing the other outside. We made predictions and then checked the results. In maths we continued our money activities, adding small numbers of coins together and working out the total. We have spent time practising for both the Christingle and the Nativity this week.

Class 2 – This week in literacy we have written a diary in the perspective of Billy from the Minpins. In maths we have started multiplication and we have learnt our two Times table. We have looked at 2D shapes. In science we have learnt how to bend water and learnt how people hear.

Class 3 – This week, in maths, we have looked at grid method multiplication. In our topic of 'Chocolate` we have continued to look at the Aztec civilisation. In literacy, we have invented our own chocolate bar and written persuasively to describe it.

Class 4 – This week, class 4 have been revising conversion between analogue, digital and 24 hour clock times and exploring the properties of 3d shapes. In English, we have competed our short stories and have started looking at the book 'The Man Who Walked Between Two Towers'. In IPC, we have been looking at the parts of the brain and their functions. Rehearsals for the Christmas Play are going well.

Sports news – This has been the last week of after school clubs. Well done to all the children who have taken part in the table tennis and archery clubs, and a special well done to any of the children who won any of the competitions.

New clubs will be starting after Christmas.

We would like to thank the PTA for their kind donation of gauntlets for the fencing kit that the children have been using.

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
