#### Curriculum update:

**Class 1** – We have started to look at the story of Paddington Bear. We have written out labels for our own Paddington Bears and we have created questions that we would like to answer based on the story. In Maths we have focused on number formation and recognition.

**Class 2** – In literacy we have been writing our own biographies about people from the past. We had our exciting dressing up day where we did watercolour portraits of our special people and led a whole school worship. In maths we have been partitioning tens and ones and looking at the values of digits. In IPC we have been learning about Emperor Qin Shi Huangdi.

**Class 3** – It's been a busy first week back for us. This week, in maths, we have started to look at multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. We have started a new topic 'Active Planet', we recorded our own emergency news broadcast. In literacy, we created a backstory for a character in our class book 'Mr Stink'.

**Class 4** – This week, in English, we have been reading 'The Lost Happy Endings' by Carol Ann Duffy and planning own prequels or sequels, which we will be writing next week. In maths, we have been working on place value and subtraction of large numbers. In IPC, we have started our new IPC topic, 'The Great, The Bold and The Brave'. We have researched the differences between the city states of Athens and Sparta.

**Sports news** – Class 1 have been learning to follow instructions both visual and verbal. In Class 2 we have been using pieces of equipment to carry out two step instructions. Class 3 have been learning the basic movements including balance coordination through dodgeball. Class 4 have been doing house matches in basketball and dodgeball.

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
