#### Curriculum update:

**Class 1** – This week we have focused on ordering numbers and number formation. In literacy we have written a sentence about the goat in the story of 'Beatrice's Goat'.

**Class 2** – This week in literacy we have worked on retelling the story of the bear under the stairs. We have also done an author study on Catherine Rayner who we were lucky enough to meet. Photographs of our wonderful trip are on the school website. In maths we have ordered the months of the year and looked at how calendars work. In IPC we produced some water colour paintings in the style of Catherine Rayner and made our Harvest hats ready for our Harvest Festival on Monday.

**Class 3** – This week, in maths, children have continued to look at shape. Children have identified features of 3D shapes and created their own 3D shapes top trumps game. In literacy, children have started to write some exciting descriptions based on our class book 'The First Drawing'. In IPC, children investigated the Stone Age diet by examining coprolite. We were also joined by Mrs Jobbins to create some excellent cave paintings.

**Class 4** – This week, in maths, we have been learning about factors and multiples. In English, we have finished writing our non-chronological reports about the kelp forests. In IPC, we have made our meals, based on a twist on a pre-historic menu and have evaluated them.

**Sports News** – Classes 1 and 2 have worked on their movement skills under pressure continuing to move into space at speed. During the balancing section of the lesson, pupils have worked well on staying stable for 3 seconds and more in new challenging positions. Classes 3 and 4 have focused more on basketball this week recapping on shooting and dribbling skills. Whilst playing in games; fairly, safely and competitively.
