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Curriculum update

Class 1 Pott Shrigley – This week class 1 have been looking at different food groups as well as locating different continents on the map. We have continued to look at ourselves by comparing similarities and differences and looking at humans and animals. In maths we have been working on number lines and in Literacy we have been creating posters.

Class 1 St John's – Another busy week! We have been talking about who is in our family and how all of our families have similarities and differences. We have also introduced our tool workshop. The children have been extremely careful in this area and are really enjoying using the real tools.

Class 2 Pott Shrigley – Class 2 have been linking their numeracy into the Ancient Egyptians by looking at shape. In literacy we are writing an adventure story based on our class book 'The Scarab's Secret'.

Class 2 St John's – In literacy we have been continuing with our quest stories which we are hoping to make into a book.

In maths we have been looking at number bonds to 100 using multiples of 5 and 10. Finally in IPC we have been comparing our homes, jobs and lifestyles with that of ancient Egyptians.

Class 3 Pott Shrigley – We have finished off our information texts based on the Stone Age. We used Powerpoint to type our information texts up, paying particular attention to the layout. In maths we have been finding the value of letters to solve equations. We have begun learning about the different states of matter in Science. (*Lewis Year 6*)

Class 3 St John's – This week in English we have started looking at flashbacks in stories- both written and in films. In maths, we have look at different subtraction strategies. In IPC, we have explored how different artists use materials in their work. We have experimented with pencils, pastels, felt and hammering using natural materials. We are really pleased with the art work we have produced.
