Curriculum update

Class 1 Pott Shrigley – This week in literacy, class one have started to explore information texts. In maths we have been exploring properties of shapes and creating interesting pictures by creating a sequence. As part of our celebration topic we have looked at Shabbat, a Jewish festival as well as exploring and learning a little more about Christmas.

Class 1 St John's – In Reception this week we have been looking at the differences between a story book and an information book. We have written our own information pages about hedgehogs. In maths we have looked at one more and one less. We have all used the interactive whiteboard to create an autumn scene.

Class 2 Pott Shrigley – Class 2 have been thinking about The Ten Commandments and how they can shape their own behaviour. They have written pledges to commit to changes they want to make. We await the transformation!

Class 2 St John's – This week we have been writing our own humorous limericks. We have also been reflecting on the Christian value of Peace and written an acrostic poem and messages of peace and hope. In maths we have been learning about place value and doubling.

Class 3 Pott Shrigley – This week we have been doing Area, Perimeter and Volume in maths and writing instructions to ride an escalator. We have made music in topic using everyday objects for effect. *Harrison Year 5*

Class 3 St John's – This week in English we have been exploring a range of instruction and explanation texts and identifying the features. In maths, we have been looking at the relationship between improper fractions and mixed numbers and revising how to add fractions together.

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
