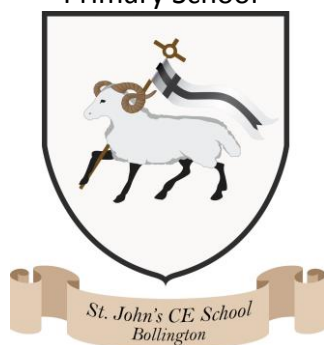

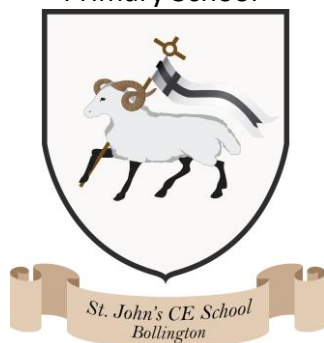
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In school next week:

Curriculum update:

Class 1 – This week we welcomed our new starters to St John's, they joined us on Wednesday afternoon to play some games and get to know us. In maths we have played snakes and ladders and worked on our turn taking skills and our counting on. In literacy we have used our Phase 4 tricky words to write super sentences. We were also lucky enough to spend the morning with Reverend Veronica at St Oswald's church for a Noah's Ark experience morning. We made animal masks, dressed up and had a feast.

Class 2 – This week in Class 2 we have written diary entries for Beegu using time connectives and adjectives. In maths we have looked at analogue and digital time, telling the time to the nearest five minutes and adding half an hour on to any given time. We were also lucky enough to spend the morning with Reverend Veronica at St Oswald's church for a Noah's Ark experience morning. We made animal masks, dressed up and had a feast.

Class 3 – This week, in maths, children have developed their proficiency with protractors by measuring and creating angles. In literacy we have created our own non-chronological report about peregrine falcons. In IPC, children have thought about the local area and examined maps of Bollington and created artwork using pipe cleaners and wire. In P.E. this week

Class 4 – This week, class 4 have been exploring the Fibonacci sequence and Pythagoras' theorem in maths. In English, we have written character descriptions and have started a new class novel called 'A Beautiful Lie' by Irfan Master. We have also been practising for the Leavers' Assembly.

Sports News – Class 1 worked on their throwing and catching skills and did some Yoga to help relax in the hot weather. Class 2 have been doing aerobics and worked on under arm throwing skills and one handed throwing skills. Class 3 have continued to practice for sports day. Class 4 have been playing a mixture of small sport's matches, including rugby, cricket, football and tennis.

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
